

Taking into account the uncertainty about the possibility of organising an in-person Congress due to administrative decisions, and above all considering the comfort and safety of the participants, related to the level of full vaccination, we have decided to use an alternative date, which means that this year's in-person **European Financial Congress in Sopot** will take place on September **13-15, 2021**.

The meetings at the European Financial Congress feature a number of important qualities, including: the possibility of an open, direct exchange of opinions and views, active interaction between the audience and the panelists, as well as the conditions for building and maintaining relations among the EFC community. The EFC round tables, panels allowing for active participation of listeners or Oxford debates require – in addition to the substantive value – also interaction and a meeting in person in an unhampered atmosphere. This is how we see this year's Congress.

We hope that by the first half of September the group of fully vaccinated people will be significantly larger than today, which will affect not only administrative decisions, but also increase the participants' sense of security.

However, the European Financial Congress operates all year round. We invite you to the 'Quarter of an Hour with the EFC' in May, in which Jan Krzysztof Bielecki and Sławomir S. Sikora will take part, as well as to the debate on "How to overcome the pandemic pessimism? A positive view on the changed reality", which will be broadcast on May 19.

On June 14, however, on the **first day of the previously planned EFC, we will broadcast hybrid EFC debates from the studio in Warsaw**, which will be focused on the problems of Finance in the changed reality, in the conditions of mid-2021.
